School Perimeter Audit Checklist

The perimeter of the school is fenced in		
The fenced area of the school grounds responds appropriately to student needs – height, type of fencing, condition of fencing (paintwork, rough/sharp edges, missing or movable pales, holes or gaps)		
Restricted areas are clearly marked		
Shrubs and foliage are trimmed to allow for good line of sight		
Perimeter fencing area is free of objects that could be used as climbing aids — such as bins, trees, lampposts		
Access points to reach transportation (cars, buses) have adequate space and clear sight lines for supervisors to monitor for safety		
There is a schedule for maintenance of fencing and gates		
Measures are in place to restrict vehicle speeds		
Gates are secured by locks		
Gates are locked after hours		
Gates are monitored throughout the day, preferably by controlled intercom		
There is a clearly marked and designated entrance for visitors		
Pedestrian and vehicular access routes are clearly designated		
Current gate openings are a suitable size for the number of students using them		
Automated gates are safe and regularly maintained
