Ian Jackson and his father Harry Sands Jackson start selling chestnut fencing stakes and hay tripods to local farmers in Kent.




1966

Ian Jackson installs the first timber treatment plant at the Jacksons Fencing timber yard in Stowting, adding value to the product.



1968

Jacksons expands into the South West of the country, setting up an additional location at Chilcompton near Bath.




1970s

1972

Jacksons takes over the Belgrave timber yard near Chester and can then also service farmers in the north west of England.



1975


Ian Jackson and his Jacksons Fencing team are pictured on the inside front pages of The Good Fencing Guide for October 1975.



1980s

Jacksons' steel security fencing and gates arrive.

In the 1980s Jacksons starts selling metal fencing to factories and schools.



1990

The company begins manufacturing steel security fencing and gates, this allows them to offer customised solutions to fit customers' individual needs.

1991

Jacksons develops automation for sliding and swing gates, domestic gates, and traffic barriers.



1997


In 1997 the company celebrated "Fifty Years of Fine Fencing".



1998

Introducing the Secret Garden Collection to the timber range.

Investment in robotic technology to help produce metal products.



2003

Installation of a powder coating plant, which provided improved service to the customer with shortened lead times, as the coating is now applied on site.



2004

Jakoustic® Sound barrier - the creation of a successful system for both commercial and residential applications that can reduce noise levels by up to 32dB.



2007

The 25 Year Service Life Guarantee was introduced for steel fencing and gates.



2010

Gate Safe Campaign was spearheaded by Jacksons following the death of two children in separate automated gate incidents.



2010

Jacksons became the first company to have a timber security fence system certified by Loss Prevention Certification Board (LPCB).



2014

In 2014 Peter Jackson, son and grandson to the founders of Jacksons Fencing took over control of the company and became Managing Director.



2015

Jacksons developed the Hedgehog Friendly Gravel Board to help the declining hedgehog population in the UK.



2016

Jacksons was contacted by Border Force, with a brief to design, manufacture and install over 11,000m of fencing securing the UK border.



2021

Jacksons introduce metal garden fence posts, Mi-TM. The company's first metal fence post for use with its garden fencing.
