Background

Some areas of the UK, much like the rest of the world, are tourism hotspots, and local authorities and councils thrive off holidaymakers visiting each year. Popular seaside destinations; Bournemouth, Christchurch, and Poole are ideal locations for families looking for a beach getaway. In the early 2000s, BCP Council (Bournemouth, Christchurch, and Poole) purchased a large amount of our timber Playtime® playground fencing, using it for multiple playparks across the coastline.

Around 20 years later, the fencing is still standing strong around these parks today, even after rebranding and equipment replacements inside the boundary.

Unfortunately, this story is uncommon; often the incorrect type of fencing is specified and installed by local authorities and councils, and in the long run ends up costing a considerable amount of extra council funding towards emergency repairs to play parks after vandalism, or the fencing falling into a state of disrepair.
