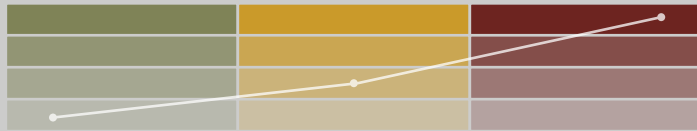


CONSIDERATIONS

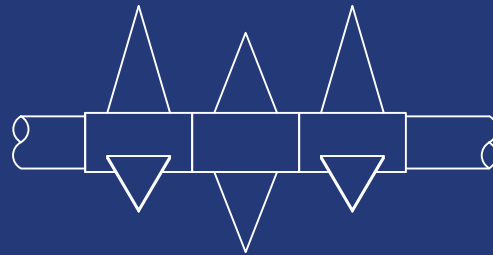

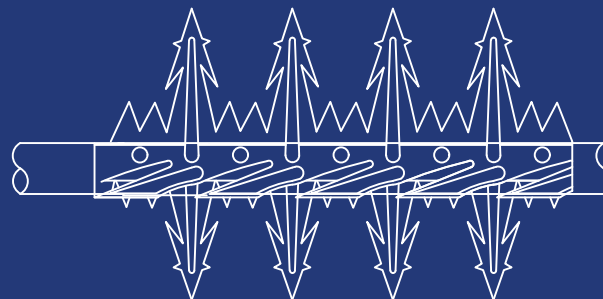

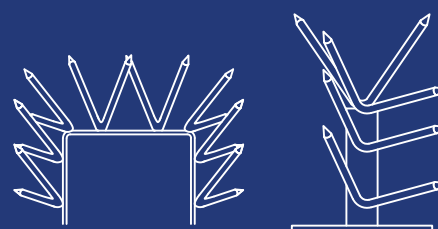

COMPLIANCE

For commercial properties, installing fence spikes is generally permitted, but businesses must meet legal and safety obligations.

DUTY OF CARE

Security toppings must not present an unreasonable risk



PLACEMENT

Spikes should typically be installed above head height

VISIBILITY

Systems should be clearly visible and not concealed, with appropriate warning/danger signs



INTENT

Designed to deter, not to cause harm

WARNINGS

Warning signs for fence spikes: We recommend 'Danger/Warning Signs' be used every 8-10m along a fence line that incorporates any security extras capable of causing injury, even through misuse.
